They complied by placing Troubles on a running chain and having a bin as shelter and a bucket of water available for Troubles. However, the chain connected to the runner was tangled up and the bin kennel was rolled away. Nobody was home so we decided to fix the situation ourselves. We added a swivel to the collar of the dog, we moved the kennel next to the one point and put bricks around it so it cannot roll away and made sure that Troubles could move up and down the runner.

We then went to Maria Kok. She had a bowl of water for Meire today and the house's door was left open so that Meire is free to come and go inside as she pleases. Maria confirmed this. As she has free roam, she can find shelter as she pleases. They complied.

The owners with the siamese cat acquired a black dog over the week. This dog is very protective but free roam. They built him a shelter on the stoep.

Livona Bassons dog named Jessica was free roaming. I observed a bucket of water. As she is roaming freely between the houses, she has access to shelter.

We then arrived at one of the tenants who had a male dog named Wollie on a runner and no issues were found. Previously he had access to dirty water but today his water was still clean.

Maria owns Gruwelik who was kept inside the house today. The installed a running chain around the entire property and is going to get a kennel for Gruwelik. The iron bin has been removed. The chain on the runner can reach a large piece of the porch where the water are kept. I advised that when they get the kennel that they can shorten the chain itself as it is heavy.

All the owners complied with their warnings. To give feedback to the complainant regarding numbers and what happened.
