General Report Comments: Hugh, Insp Navesh Singh (Nspca Farm Unit), Insp DJ White (Nspca Farm Unit) and I, Elani arrived at the Tomis Abattoir for a routine inspection. We met Bok and he gave us access to inspect the premises.

DJ and I inspected the dirty area and Navesh and Hugh inspected the clean area. We were there whilst the facility was unoperational and most people were on lunch.

The sheep slaughter areas conveyer belt broke and needed to be fixed. As DJ and I went up to this area we observed sheep waiting in the slaughter run with no access to water. We instructed the employees to put them back in the lairages. When they did this we noticed that there were closed gates between the enclosures that can be opened. The one side the sheep has access to water and the other side they did not. We instructed the employee to move them to enclosures with water or open the gates. He opened the gates and the problem was solved.

We joined Navesh and Hugh at the cattle dirty area and found that the new gridding was insufficient and broken. We advised that they rather make grooves to prevent slipping. The panels were also fixed but still problematic.

We found a solution to add thick metal to the connecting openings at Thomas.

Returning to the sheep we observed one of the employees twisting the tails of sheep and pulling them by their legs when he handled them. I addressed him and showed him how to move the sheep. He complied.

To issue warning to Tomis tomorrow.
