General Report Comments: Hugh and I, Elani arrived at the property and met with Karen Carr who is the chef of the restaurant. She was the only person available to assist excluding the cashier.

We introduced ourselves and informed her that we are there for a routine inspection. All the animals did have access to shelter in some shape or form. All the camps are sandy as the grass and bushes have been trampled because of overgrazing.

She took us through the property to show the animals. We first went to the main enclosure where most of the birds were. The ponds water was extremely dirty and needs to be replaced. There were excess faeces and multiple hazardous objects inside this enclosure. They also did not have access to clean potable water and had limited nest boxes. The water bath here was empty. The poultry are able to move freely across the entire property.

We then saw the donkeys who were kept in a large enclosure filled with scrap material and asked to see the water container for this. She told us it is on the other side of the property. We then saw the cattle grazing in a field with lots of hazardous scrap material.

We walked back to see the conditions of the sheep and leopard tortoises. We only observed one leopard tortoise. Karen was uncertain about most of the information I asked her like the permits and licenses as she is only the chef. The leopard tortoise and sheep did not have access to water at all. In this bath we found a dead bird and told Karen to have someone immediately remove it. The water containers were extremely dirty.

Karen told us that the caretaker just did not pitch for work today. When asked, who takes care of the animals then, she admitted that nobody does. She also mentioned that the owner has several businesses and does not stay closeby. She also informed us that nobody lives onsite except external tenants. There was also no supervision for the public.

No rodent or fly control was observed.

We then walked around the property to find where the cattle and donkey water container was and saw that it was empty.

We then went into the abandoned nursery and saw more shelter and rabbits. The rabbits are already feral.

The bedding for all animals was wet and dirty.

There were also holes in the ground where cattle can trip and break their legs. They claim to use WAHG as a veterinarian.

Karen was also unsure about the status of their Cape Nature permit and PAPA license. The ideal would be for the owner to surrender most of the animals to us.
