General Report Comments: I, Elani, got the court order from Magistrate Brenda Mpako at Wellington Magistrates Court.

Hugh and I were then assisted by Sgt Pietersen and Const Jones to the property.

When we arrived, we were lucky to find the owner has just stopped there. I greeted him and introduced ourselves again. I told him we have a court order to inspect his property. He was calm and let us inside. Hugh was taking a video of the inspection.

His dog named Buks was eating. I asked to see his entire premises but he claimed there was no other animals. As Hugh and I walked around the back yard we could see lots of stuff lying around with excess faeces everywhere. The corridor on the side of the house had no animals even though there was signs of animals being there.

When we walked to the front Sgt Pietersen was yelling at Mr Bam as he set the dog on them to bite them and they had to pepper spray the dog. They had a quarrel.

He has a large shaded shed area that was very clean and this is where he kept the dog food and water. We walked around the front yard and he showed me where Buks sleeps and there was another automatic water filler. I noticed there is a gap in the floor where Buks has to jump to get to his shelter and advised him to build a bridge for the dog there.

We then asked if we can see the inside of the house for animals. He got hostile as he wants his privacy and didn't want Hugh to take video evidence to which I showed him that we can. The house inside was very clean and no animals were seen.

He showed me Bravecto and the dewormer he bought for Buks over the weekend.

I then explained to Mr Bam I could have seized his dog but will be reasonable and issue him with a warning to take Buks to the veterinarian for his hips and clean the place up, possibly close off the back section of the yard.

I issued a warning to:

- 1) Provide Buks with veterinary treatment within 48 hours as he walks with difficulty. Send the veterinary report to inspectorate@wellingtonspca.co.za
- 2) Clean Buks' living environment as discussed from hazardous material and excess faeces within 7 days.

Albie was calm and signed the warning. He mentioned that Dr George knows him.

To follow up on veterinary treatment on Wednesday.
