General Report Comments: I, Elani arrived at Tomis and met with Bok to discuss the way forward with the cattle run . He said they used a diamond drill to cut grooves in the cement and they welded the side panels of the run.

He then got everyone together including Rikus, Aiden, Tjaart and other employees to walk with me and discuss how they can better the work they did and the way forward.

The abattoir was very quiet today. We all went to the cattle run. They have made massive improvements over Decembers by replacing some of the panels, welding strips on the exposed panels and drilling grooves on the concrete floor.

No cattle was in the run today being slaughtered as it was extremely quiet so I could not observe cattle going through the run. They claim that the cattle dont slip anymore and that the grooves helps a lot.

I saw a few more areas of concern and suggested if slipping continues, to either deepen the grooves or make more compact grooves. I also suggest d of somebody does a weekly check and fix the minor issues, then it wont be as big of a job as now. They agreed to do weekly checks and fix the remaining finishing touches in the run.

Tomis have complied but I did go back to Bok and relayed all the information and informed him that I will come back in about a months time to see how its going. He agreed.

They also are considering hiring out our cat traps again and transport it themselves. I made a suggestion to catch a few cats, sterilize them and make sure they are healthy and then release them back into the system as this will help with pest control and keep new feral cat colonies away.
