General Report Comments: I, Elani arrived at Florida and spoke to Karen that did not know much about what has changed. She showed me to three guys that were on the premises tending to the animals.

I mainly dealt with Jan who said he worked for Dimitri for years already. I asked him to show me the changes that was made on the premises and he assisted me.

They removed the old rusted structure that was previously built for goats. They got rid of the donkeys. They continuously replace the water in the dams for the geese. He also understood the practicality of making a cement floor for the dams. They do have an exit pipe for when they clean. All the baths were overflowing with water. He also showed me the poles they have planted in the ground to surround the scrap metal area. He said they are just waiting for the fence and will put it on when they have it. He understood that the cows can eat plastic as this scrap area is still full of hazardous material and accessible to the cattle. He also understood the function of fly traps. He also showed me that they cleared out all the greenhouses from rubble.

I then received a message from Dimitri who was on holiday up until now wanting to know what he must still fix. I sent him the following:

Hope you are well.

I went to Florida Padstall today and dealt with Jan Geduld to follow-up on the progress of the premises.

I see that they have worked extremely hard in the cleanup of the facility even though there are still progress to be made. He also showed me the poles that have been planted to enclose the scrap area so that the cows cannot enter this area as there are lots of wire, injurious objects and plastic lying around. The things I have discussed with him are as follows:

To continue clearing the fields from hazardous materials.

To obtain fencing to enclose the scrap area.

To clear out the dams and make a proper long-term cement base for the dam. This will be easier to keep clean and maintain in the long run. As the water is stagnant it gets dirty much easier with the soil as the flooring. This also absorbs into the soil. I suggest a cement base or old cement dams for the birds. It will also be easier to place an exit pipe when it needs to be cleaned.

To place fly traps on the outskirts of the enclosures to control disease.

To keep the colourful nesting boxes for the geese in their enclosure as a choice of shelter for them.

To move/remove the three (3) beehives from underneath the one veranda so that this can be used as additional shelter for the animals. It is also dangerous if an animal gets stung by them.

I will be able to collect the tortoises next week from you. Let us make an appointment for Tuesday to collect them? I would still like to meet you if you can. You are more than welcome to ask if you unclear about anything.

Look forward to hearing from you

Awaiting his response. To collect 2 leopard tortoises for surrender on Tuesday. And follow up in 2 weeks time.
