General Report Comments: Hugh and I, Elani arrived at the property and met with the owner Ayse . She has Beenese Mountain dogs and not St Bernards.
We explained the situation but she already expected us .
She took us through to where the puppies are kept so we could examine their weight. She has two left. These two did not have protruding spines or hip bones and were in fair condition.
Ayse claimed that this was an accidental pregnancy . Bear is very old and seems to have hip issues but the mother dog is in good condition.
The puppies are kept in a seperate space with a bed outside and water and has access to a back room for shade and shelter.
I then asked whether the dogs has had theor shots and when she is getting paid so she can give all of her dogs basic treatment for tick and fleas and dewormers. She said ahe gets money from the UK around the 1st of November as it takes a few days to enter her account.
I asked her to show me the animal food she has and she feeds Catmor for her cats and Vitagen for her dogs.
I then educated her about puppy food that would be essential for nutrients for the puppies and bear. Bear has a hotspot on his tail and is thinner than the rest. We also explained that he need to go to a veterinarian for this as he has been there more than six months ago. I also explained that she is more than welcome to use our mobile clinic where the consult is R220. She showed me the current booklets for the pups and I saw it was done by Paarl SPCA and they were due the 7th of October for their second jab.

I then issued a warning to:
1) Ensure to provide adequate puppy food for the puppies within 72 hours.
2) Provide all the dogs with adequate tick and flea treatment and dewoemer by the 3rd of November 2025.
3) Provide Bear with veterinary treatment for his hips by the 3rd of November 2025.

We then gave her a Wellington SPCA pamphlet with all our details and prices and she signed the warning.

To follow up within 72hours and the 3rd of November 2025.
