General Report Comments: Inspector Elani and i, Trainee Inspector Hugh went to the area. We then started our inspection at 1 Green dolphin street until 24 Green dolphin street (including streets that intersect with Green dolphin)

1 Green Dolphin street:

We arrived at the property and we called from the outside. Fransiena Stuurman then arrived outside and we greeted her and introduced ourselves. We also explained what our cause was for being there and she was pleased.

We saw her dog laying on a patch of grass in the front area and we noticed that she had no water to drink. We then asked her to fill up her water bowl and also asked her where her shelter was. She then took us to the back area and showed us an inadequate shelter for her dog named Kate. We then educated her on a proper kennel and she mentioned that Kate will be getting a kennel through Fransiena's employer. We then gave her tick and flea treatment (fiprotec). She also mentioned that Kate is sterilized as additional information. We also gave her our clinic details and explained the conditions/services of the clinic.

Elani then issued warning 187 to:

- Kate did not have access to adequate shelter or potable water.
- Provide drinking water for Kate at all times.
- Provide adequate shelter/fix the current kennel within 7 days.

3 Green dolphin street

Inspector Elani and i, Trainee Inspector Hugh arrived at the neighbour of Fransiena Stuurman. We then called from the outside and met with an extremely aggressive dog roaming loose in the yard. The fencing also did not seem adequate and the dog could possibly get out. Dolly van Wyk then came outside to greet us and she informed us that they have a running change for the dog called Roefie but it broke. We asked whether she could move the dog to another area so we could come inside and she mentioned that she cannot control the dog.

We then asked her whether the dog had proper shelter and we could see that he had adequate water. The dog which is named Roefie had a kennel but was not adequate as well and we then educated them on a proper raised flooring/lifted kennel. She then understood and another resident came outside with a puppy. We then educated her on how important vaccinations are and sterilization. She then understood and we gave both dogs tick and flea treatment. We also gave her our clinic pamphlets.

Elani then issued warning 188 to:

- Provide Roefie with an adequate shelter by lifting the flooring and clearing it from rubbish within 7 days.

3 Koala street (intersecting street)

We called from the outside and was greeted by Jacob van Staden. We could see from the outside that the dog had an obstruction in front of its shelter preventing it possibly from getting inside. We then educated the owner on how it was important for the dog to be protected from the elements and he understood. We also saw that the water bowl of the dog named Buksie was empty and we then educated them on how the dogs could overheat especially in the warm upcoming days. He then understood and we gave him our clinic details as well as tick/flea treatment.

Elani then issued warning 189 to:

- Buksie did not have access to water and had an obstruction on the entrance of shelter.
- Provide drinking water for the dog at all times.
- Fix Buksie's kennel within 7 days as discussed.

9 Green dolphin street

Elani and I, Hugh arrived at the property and was greeted by a crowd of people standing inside the property. We then introduced ourselves and explained our reason for being there and they understood.

We then entered the front gate and saw the dog roaming the front area. The owner explained that this is where he is kept. The dog named Tyson had shelter as well as access to water and was in fair condition.

No contraventions of the APA found.

11 Green dolphin street

We approached the property and Anthony Mars was there to greet us. We then greeted him and introduced ourselves as well as our reason for being there. He then agreed and allowed us to inspect the area.

From the gate we could see that the dog named Nala was on a heavy static chain and we asked what his reason was for this. He then mentioned that Nala is very destructive towards his crops mainly and that's why he chains her. We then educated him on a running chain and he understood but also mentioned he will untie her so she could roam freely as his yard is adequately fenced. We also observed that she had a problem with ticks as well and we gave him tick and flea treatment. Nala had shelter from the elements.

The other dog was a bit younger and named Lula. She was roaming freely and she was full of energy. She was in fair condition and we gave her tick and flea treatment. Lula had shelter from the elements.

Elani then issued warning 190 to:

- Nala was on a heavy static chain upon arrival.
- Ensure that Nala is on a running chain or free roaming in the yard within 7 days.

3 Beaver street(intersecting street)

We arrived at the property and called from the outside. The owner Maronette Dankers then came outside to greet us and we introduced ourselves. She then allowed us access and she mentioned that her dog had just had pups. We observed the dog named Kiara as being underweight. We then walked towards the puppies and saw that their area where they are kept is dirty/parasitic. The shelter which they were kept in was not adequate. We then educated Maronette on this and she understood. We also asked her to get puppy food for Kiara so that she could gain weight. We then gave Kiara tick and flea treatment.

Elani then issued warning 191 to:

- Provide water and adequate food for the dogs as discussed.
- The dogs living environment is dirty and has hazardous material and the shelter needs to be fixed.
- Provide adequate shelter for the dogs(threesided walls,raised flooring,waterproof roof) within 7 days.
- Clean the living environment from hazardous material within 7 days.

4 Beaver street(intersecting street)

We arrived at the property and was greeted by Zelerie Daniel's. We then introduced ourselves and she allowed us access to the property.

We then went inside and saw that the property is not adequately fenced but the dog named Liefie was in okay condition. He had shelter and water.

No contraventions of the APA was found.

13 Green dolphin street

We arrived at the property and called from the outside. Adrian du plessis came outside to greet us and he allowed us access. We then went inside and saw a budgie with a clean cage as well as clean water. We then went to a separate area where the dogs are kept and we could not see a kennel but both dogs were in fair condition. We could also see some hazardous material laying in the back where the dogs are kept. We then educated the owner on how the animals need to be protected from the elements and how the hazardous material could cause unnecessary injury. We also educated him on the importance of water for both dogs especially since we are approaching the hot season and he then understood.

Elani then issued warning 193 to:

- Upon arrival the dogs were kept in area that has hazardous material, no drinking water and no shelter.
- Ensure to provide water at all times.
- Ensure to clean the living area from hazardous material within 7 days.
- Ensure to provide adequate shelter(waterproof roof and raised flooring within 7 days).

16 Green dolphin street

We called from the outside and nobody was home. We then observed two animals on the property

and the property was not adequately fenced. We saw food but could not see shelter or water .

Elani then issued warning 192 to:

-Contact the SPCA to discuss your animals within 24 hours.
