General Report Comments: Inspector Elani and I, Trainee Inspector Hugh arrived at the premises. We then went inside and greeted the receptionist who then called Rickus to accompany us.

Moments later Rickus and Aiden came to greet us. They then accompanied us on the follow up inspection and we walked to the sheep lairages first.

SHEEP

On the initial inspection some sheep holding areas had no access to water and this was corrected by them installing automatic water dispensers in every part.

We also observed that the ramps had loose gridding, bent metal and a deceased sheep in them on the initial inspection. This was corrected by fixing the gridding, metal and removing the deceased sheep.

All the contraventions on the sheep area was then corrected and we were pleased.

CATTLE

We then moved towards the cattle area and they mentioned that we should watch the slaughter of the cattle as they will be stopping slaughter in a few minutes due to employees going on breaks. We then went and observed the Cattle slaughter from the outside due to the fact that there was no other entrance in to the Cattle slaughter area (clean). We then watched the stun to bleed which was 15 seconds and the bleed out time was 8 minutes and 15 seconds.

We were then pleased with this process and moved on to the dirty area.

On the initial inspection we saw that the cattle runs had some batteries, aluminum cans and plastic rubble in it. We then walked through the runs and saw it had been cleaned and removed.

We also went to the Cattle holding area where a meat hook was observed which could possibly injure the animals. This was also removed.

All issues had been corrected and training was provided to the necessary staff by the management. Every person was held accountable for the contraventions during our initial inspection.
