General Report Comments: Hugh and I Elani arrived at the property and noticed a dog lying outside. We then called out and women came out to assist us. They informed us Adenaan is at a family members house and not there. We asked about the dog with a broken leg and they confirmed it to be the one lying by our feet. We asked them to pick him up to show whether he can walk and he couldn't step on his right hind leg. Apparently he has been left like this for a month without treatment. We explained the definition of the owner to them according to the APA 71 of 1962. They got a fright and gave us permission to inspect the other animals on the property.

We went to the back where two chickens are kept without a permit. They had water and shelter, no food and lived amongst rubbish and excrement. Inside the house they have two quails in a caged without food and hiding space. They did have water.

Inside the bedroom, a mother cat was seen with 4 kittens of whom are all sick.

We explained the seriousness of either taking the animals to the veterinarian or surrendering them otherwise I will prosecute.

I issued a FINAL (we have been here numerous times where Adenaan always has new sick animals) warning to:

- 1) You have the option to surrender the animals to the SPCA.
- 2) Bongo appears to have a broken hind leg. Provide Bongo with veterinary treatment within 22 hours.
- 3) Provide your cats with cat food within 22 hours.
- 4) Clean the chicken coop and quail cage within 48 hours and provide feed to them.
- 5) The 4 kittens appears to have severe snuffles and no food. Provide the cats with veterinary treatment within 22 hours.

Marelise signed the warning and said she will give it to Adenaan. They are aware of our mobile clinic as well.

To follow up within 22 hours.
