General Report Comments: Elani and i,Hugh arrived at the business.We then went to greet Carl who was sitting in his office and he then allowed us access to the premises.

We walked to the sheep/goats lairages and some of sheep had adequate water dispensers but most of them did not have any.We then did a walk through the lairages and this time found no injured sheep or goats.

We then went to the cattle lairages and we saw that they had rebuilt some of them .We did a walk through and noticed that all of them except for one did not have any water in them. We also noticed that most of the hazardous material was also removed from the lairages.

We then went and watched the cattle loading and offloading .We saw that they had used metal railings on the side which was better than last time.The last time the sides were exposed and this could cause injury.

We then went to the sheep loading and offloading area .We inspected all vehicles and saw that some of them who were waiting to load had no non slip flooring. We then told employees that no animals will be loaded on the vehicles who has no non slip flooring and they pointed them in the direction to receive sand/oathay in the back of their vehicles to make it non slip.The loading process then continued but we then educated staff again on how training should be taken seriously and that they should educate the public on safe transporting as they wanted to load animals in this manner.

We then left after all the loading was completed .
