When asked whether he has a phone to contact the owner with emergencies, he said he doesnt own a phone and just waits for the owner to come when he does. We noticed in the notebook with gordons number that Purbac and Inflacam was written down . When asked who medicates the dogs, Johan said the owner. We know that inflacam should be given daily and the owner doesnt visit the farm daily which is a concern. The black dog has a geowth that is starting to form wounds on its neck.

I issued a warning to:

- 1) Your black dog has a massive growth on its throat. Provide your dog with veterinary treatment within 48 hours and provide proof thereof to the spca.
- 2)Contact the Spca to set up a time to meet within 24 hours.
