I still issued a warning to:

- 1) Provide Wanda and all other two dogs with appropriate tick and flea treatment within 14 days. (Because of payday) Buy Nexguard/ Bravecto and keep packaging as proof.
- 2) This can be bought by our clinic, Wahg. Karbadust can be bought by Agrimark for the environment

To follow up on tick and flea treatment within a month and to remove stitches of wanda on Monday .
