General Report Comments: I, Elani arrived on a secluded farm with three main buildings. I called Hannalette twice and she did not answer her phone. I went to each house and called out for someone as cars were parked outside. I then tried calling Hannalette again and this time she answered saying she stays at the house with the blue car.

I went there and met with Hannalette. She allowed me inside. Downstairs there is a bedroom and their cat was sleeping in the cupboard here.

We then went upstairs where the main living space is. There were several animal beds, I saw water and food bowls and a cat litter tray. She also has a rabbit that has recently been groomed. It is an unsterilized male. I asked her whether she has thought about sterilization. She has spoken to Dr Morkel and some veterinarians say rabbits are sensitive to the anaesthetics and can die easily. She is not planning to get another rabbit. He has his own living space cage with water, food and a bed and is allowed outside of the cage. There is also a balcony that the cats can explore on.

Their cat Koei is 17yo and has cropped ears due to cancer that had to be cut out by Dr Barry from WAHG. They make use of Wellington animal hospital.

Hannalette and her husband works for themselves and are mostly home.

Hannalette understood the integration of a new kitten to a home. She prefers to take the cat on Monday when everyone is home as they are away on Saturday.

The cat will mostly be inside the house and she will monitor if the cat goes outside.

The house is alone standing on a farm and does not have an enclosed yard. The neighbours have two border collie mix dogs.
