General Report Comments: I, Elani arrived at the property and called for assistance. Angeline Pietersen, Reubens grandmother came outside to speak to me. I explained why I am there and took a look at what Rueben has done in a week.

I saw he cleaned out half of the alleyway, providing the other half to Leila. Leila was not on a chain and had access to water and a broken shelter. It was still dirty and there was still hazardous material inside her enclosure. I explned the solutions to Angeline on how to fix the situation as they had the materials to fix it.

I issued a warning to:

-Leilas living environment is still littered with faeces and her shelter does not have flooring.

1) clean Leilas living environment from hazardous material and faeces within 3 days

2) Ensure to provide adequate flooring and three sided shelter for Leila within 3 days. (Use bricks and board as flooring and enclose the one side of the kennel to protect her from the elements.)

To follow up on Monday

I then continued to Nolans dogs who were confined in an enclosure. Instead if building running chains, he decided to build them a large envlosure out of pallets with a gate. They can roam greely in and out of the kennel now. They had water avalailable as well. We then placed the water container in a brick filled crate so they cannot knock it over. I also suggested that he makes more dry flooring inside the shelter for them to lie on. Because of his hard work I gave him a dip bottle and our pamphlet and educated him about Nexguard, Bravecto and our Mobile Clinic.

I will follow up within 3 weeks on their skin condition.
