General Report Comments: Elani arrived at the property that is quite large. I called out and saw that 5 dogs came running to the front of which 3 were puppies.

After a while a man named Andy came to assist me. I informed him why I was there and asked whether I can see the dog that is chained. He gave me access to the property and showed me where the chained dog was. Roxy on a static chain at the back with a chain around its neck, no access to water, no access to shelter and its living environment was filled with rubbish and dirt.

He told me the dog belongs to Leighton but he is still under 18. Andy is his uncle and I informed him that the adults are the owners of the dogs, not Leighton. He understood. I then explained to him what they can do in order to improve Roxys living environment and he understood.

I issued a warning to:

Roxy is on a static chain without drinking water or adequate shelter in dirty conditions.

- 1) Clean Roxys living environment from rubbish and hazardous material within 7 days.
- 2) Ensure all dogs have access to water at all times ( place bucket in tyre/crate with bricks)
- 3) Ensure to provide Roxy with an adequate collar within 7 days (piping around neck/leather collar)
- 4) Provide Roxy with adequate shelter within 7 days (place pallet inside veranda with solid board on top away from elements)
- 5) Provide Roxy with a running chain within 7 days.

I then educated him on what to feed and what not to feed the dogs. He then signed the warning with a cross as he couldn't write. I explained the five things to him again in detail and asked whether he understood and Andy confirmed that he understood.

To follow up within 7 days.
