General Report Comments: Liciano and I, Elani found the complainant on Jan van Riebeeck drive. She showed us where she saw the dog last disappearing into the houses. We went to that house facing the road and spoke to a man asking him whether he knows where the dog comes from. He did and explained to us exactly how to get there. We drove around into Van Wyksvlei road and saw the house and dog in question outside.

There was a woman outside the house named Ellen Fortuin. We introduced ourselves and explained how we got there and informed her Leah ran in the main road. Leah was very underweight and has three puppies. Their yard is open at the back and front allowing the dogs to run in the road. We asked where the dogs shelter and water was. She claimed to give the dog water twice a day and that they sleep inside. However there was no sign of water and the door to the house was closed.

I then issued her with a warning explaining in detail what they need to do as they have lots of scrap material to work with. They can either close the back section of the house or place the adult dogs on a running chain. I issued a warning to:

- 1) Ensure that all your animals have access to drinking water at all times.
 - 2) Your dog Leah was found running in Jan van Riebeeck road. Ensure to enclose your property as discussed or provide each dog with a running chain within 7 days.
 - 3) Leah is underweight. Ensure to buy adequate dog food (preferably puppy food) and feed twice a day within 7 days. Do not feed bones, potato peels and pap.
 - 4) Provide Leah and the puppies with dewormer within 7 days.
