We explained that the dog needs yo go to the vet immediately or they can contact us to pick the dog up for euthanasia.

I issued a warning to:

- 1)Provide Ceaser with adequate veterinary treatemnt within 48 hours. Provide us with proof thereof.
- 2) Place Ceasar on a running chain within 7 days/ let him roam freely
- 3) Provide your dog with and adequate collar within 7 days (piping)
- 4) You have the option to surrender Ceasar to the SPCA.

Nicolette said she will speak to her husband that is away for work. We also explained where and when our mobile clinic is for veterinary advice. We told her to contact us as soon as the fog needs help.
