General Report Comments: Hugh and I, Elani did a follow up on the Liens dogs yo see whether they have gained weight over the last month.

Lien/Cindy Faro:

The dogs have gained some weight but are not there yet. The dogs have developed skin conditions appearing like mange. I issued a warning to:

- 1) Provide the mother dog with veterinary treatment within 48 hours due to her skin condition. Our mobile clinic is on the corner of Springbok way and Jan van Riebeeck rd on Tue and Thu from 09:00 to 11:00.
- 2) You also have the option to surrender the dog to the SPCA.

Jasmine Jantjies:

She owns one of the puppies which appeared emaciated upon arrival. We discussed her way forward and that the puppy needs adequate food. I have dewormed him before so it cannot be that. I issued a warning to:

- 1) Provide Tyson with adequate puppy food within 48 hours.
- 2) You have the option to surrender the dog over to the SPCA.

Betty Bastiaan 0625109907:

I walked past a property and heard a dog barking but couldnt see it. I then called for the owner and saw a dog named Wagter kept on a static chain with no adquate shelter or water. He was also sitting on a rusted piece of metal and had hazardous material around him that can cause injuries. I then explained to the owner what they should change to make the situation better. She kept on saying that the dog bites people.

I issued a warning to:

- 1) Provide Wagter with a running chain or enclose the property within 7 days.
- 2) Provide your dogs with water at all times.
- 3) Clean Wagters area from hazardous material within 7 days
- 4) Provide adequate shelter within 7 days (three sided, raised flooring, roof)

To follow up on Jasmine and Liens fogs on Friday and on Bettys property on Tuesday.

Samantha Jantjies surrendered her dog named Bokbek over to us.
