General Report Comments: Sheldon and I, Elani arrived at Leeurivier for a follow up.

We first went to Magdalena Faros place. They were not at home. The dogs were outside. The mother dog was still in bad condition and was feeding one puppy. They did not have drinking water. I issued a FINAL warning to:

- 1) Provide water for you dogs at all times.
- 2) Provide Cindy with adequate veterinary treatment within 48 hours
- 3) You have the option to surrender the animals to the SPCA.

We then went to Jasmines property with the puppy. They were also not home but her son was. I asked him to show me whether they bought puppy food and the puppy. The puppy looked better than the previous visit and they did buy Mobtego Puppy for the dog. We then gave the puppy Triworm D.

Johanna Adams then approached us to surrender her two cats of which one is sterilized. They cannot afford to look after them anymore.

I then went to Betty Bastiaan to see whether they complied. They placed Wagter on a long running chain, got a soft collar for him, he had a bowl of water and the area was cleaned. There is a Wendy that provides shelter but it does not have adequate flooring. I educated Betty on what they can do and she agreed.

I want to go back with Dip and a kennel for Bettys dog. Also follow up on Magdalena.

As we went back to the car, the owner of Leeuwrvier named Damelien Kruger stopped us and said we must speak to her in the office. We went there and she was very hostile asking what the purpose of the SPCA is and that she doesn't want to play mother anymore and asked what the purpose of the SPCA is. I explained in detail what the difference between Law Enforcement (government) and the SPCA (NGO) is. She then said she never received a list of sterilizations. I told her I gave it to her daughter and had a long discussion previously with her daughter about the issue at hand. She said she does not have money to sterilize the animals and how is it her responsibility to remove the animals and people. I told her that it is their premises, they have a contract, they need to get a good civil lawyer for the Heritage people and they will have to give money out if they want to solve the problem. I even gave a personal example of what another farmer has done successfully. She refused and we left. She also said we must remove the animals and not let them suffer. I told her that we have been there on numerous occasions and I cannot do much if the people comply with the warnings, which they always do.
