General Report Comments: Hugh, and I, Elani arrived at the property and met with Reni Hildenbrand. She was surprised to see us again.

We gave her the vaccination cards for the cats we returned and forgotten to give her and got our one cat carrier back.

We then discussed with her that we received a concern about her blind baby goat and the other goats in the camp. She got confused and immediately wanted to know who complained. We explained that we cannot give her that information.

She then showed us the goat milk that she bought specifically for the blind goat as the mother goat rejected him and did not feed him. She also premade some bottles and then decided to take us through to them.

We then walked towards the camp where the sheep and goats are kept.

Since my court order, things have been maintained that I issued warnings for.

The blind goat named Bernie, its sibling and its mother were kept in a separate camp from the rest of the goats and sheep under a tree. Allog them had access to clean potable water and adhoc feed. She then fed Betnie a bottle. The goats are in good condition and does not appear to be thin at all. I then went into the large camp where the adult goats are kept with two sheep to observe the wendy house spoken about.

At night, Reni explained that she takes the three separate goats and sheep, down to an enclosed sheep house to keep them safe at night. The rest of the adult goats she encloses in the wendy house. She closes them in at night because of natural predators.

The goats and sheep had ad hoc feed and water available.

Inside the wendy there is a large feeding trough, a bucket of water and an additional bucket of pellets for when they are kept in there at night. The wendy is raised and excess faeces and food falls through the floor to the outside. The inside of this wendy house is clean.

We then went to the sheep house where the mom goat and two kids and 2 sheep are kept. This area has bedding, water bowls and feeding troughs available. There is also a gate that gets locked at night to keep them safely inside.

She also stated that Dr Willem from WAHG was there the previous week to castrate the male kids and to check their welfare.

No welfare concerns were observed and we could see that she is maintaining all the changes she made according to the warnings I left in the past.
