General Report Comments: I, Elani did a case at 6A Commissioner which we have been to previously. As I looked for the house, I noticed ywo german shepherds that are kept in a house parking lot in parasitic conditions with excess faeces. They only had the parking roof as shelter and did not have access to potable water from what I could see. I suspect this is the house in question that people keep complaining about. I also noticed stale water in the roads drain causing a health risk. There was also a Boerboel on the side of the house. I do not know how many animals live here therefore I issued a warning to:

- 1)It was observed that two German Shepherds are living in parasitic conditions and possibly other animals as well without potable water.
- 2) Contact the SPCA within 24 hours to set up a time to meet.
- 3) Clean all animals living conditions from excess faeces.
- 4) Ensure all animals have access to potable water at all times.
- 5) Ensure the German shepherd has adequate shelter within 7 days.

I left the warning in the gate as seen in photos.
