General Report Comments: I, Elani arrived at the property and met with the workers present at the time. I immediately saw that both dogs were free roaming in the property. I then explained why I was there and Rafiq said the owner is not there. I asked why the dogs were tied up previously as I could see the evidence of the ropes and he said that they washed the dogs like this and then loosened them.

I went to the back of the property where the dogs are kept. They had two half drum water sources available and a massive kennel that is split in half with two entrances.it had doors with locks on. I asked about this and the worker claimed this is for when the dog gets puppies. the shelter is wooden inside and covered outside with sheet metal. It was cool inside because of the wind but if the door has to be closed, there wont be enough ventilation. I then educated the workers as to if the dog ever has to get preganant again that yhey should leave the doors open and rather build a makeshift fence around the entrance of the kennel so that the mother and pups can move freely in and out of the kennel. The workers understood this. They have lots of pallets they can use for this. I then went back inside and they showed me the food they feed to the dogs. I then educated them about our mobile clinic and the importance of sterilization and gave them an information pamphlet. They said they will give it to the owner of the dogs.

I found no contraventions of the APA in the time of my inspection .
