General Report Comments: I, Elani arrived at the property and met with Wilhelmina and her two sisters that are visiting her. They confined the Pitbull to protect me but the puppy was free roaming and allowed to go in and out of the house.

They are still awaiting Lae Enforcement to pick up the Pitbull for surrender.

They explained to me that Wilhelmina's son died just before Christmas and that the pitbull belonged to him. This clarified a lot why Wilhelmina cannot look after him.

She has a corner property which is very large and has a massive yard right around.

There is no separation of back to front. I then asked whether she could drive and she said yes. I asked what she would do if she has to go somewhere as there is a small confined space by the back door of the house. She said she would confine both dogs there, pull the car out and then go back inside to let them out because what is the point of having dogs if they cannot run the yard and protect it whilst away. This was acceptable.

She also said the dogs will be allowed inside. I did observe her puppy's food and water bowl inside the kitchen. She has brought Montego puppy for him. However, outside there was no shelter to protect the dogs from the elements. I then asked whether she is willing to get a kennel that both can fit in and she agreed. We have a large one that she can buy from us. They agreed to buy this.

As the owner is on crutches I told her she is lucky to have a big yard as she cannot walk the dogs but if her nieces and nephews come over they can. I also mentioned getting a ball and exercising the dogs in this way. This is when her sister went to get a brand new toy that they bought for the dogs already.

I then asked whether she has family close by and they said the brother stays in the property to the back of hers if she ever needs help to take the dogs to the veterinarian and so on. It was good to know they stay next to each other.

I then also mentioned that if the time comes that she must move or something happens, to bring Rainbow back to the SPCA and they understood and agreed.

They also mentioned they want a friend for the puppy so he isn't alone and when asked she said she wants a dog as a companion and not security as the first choice. This was good to hear.

Pre home check approved. They are so willing to ask for help and work with us.
