General Report Comments: I, Elani arrived at the property and met with Carlos. He allowed me access to the property. All the dogs were free roaming in the front yard and had access to the house. In case of emergencies, the dogs have a garage to use as shelter outside. He claims the dogs are mostly inside. The cats and dogs can move freely in and out of the house and have water and food buckets available.

There are several beds in the house where the dogs can sleep.

He then mentioned a blind dog. We went to the back yard where this dog is kept and he is kept here as he is blind and knows the environment. He has a large yard with water and shelter. He was born with blindness and a split nose. He runs in curcles. I checked the eras and found it to be dirty and gave the owner our mobile clinic pamphlet to take the dog for treatment for this. The cats also mostly are using this yard.

He also mentioned he gets a mobile groomer to assist with shaving Trompie as it is impossible for them to handle.

He said he will come to our mobile clinic for treatment as it is cost efficient.

Lets see by the end of the week if he complies with this. He also agreed to do their vaccinations by us.

He also has rabbits on his farm in an enclosure with potable water. He had a box as shelter for them i educated him to get a more solid shelter before the winter for the rabbits.

To follow up by the end of the week to see whether he went to our mobile clinic.
