I, Dr AS Muller, ID 7603310043, was asked to perform a clinical examination on a horse owned by L. Jordaan from Buffelskraal, Albertinia.

Examination Findings

- Horse is in poor body condition. Body condition score of 2.5/9 (Good being 4.5/9).
- Mentation is alert and attentive, she has a healthy appetite.
- Molars in maxilla have slight hooks left and right, but she is able to chew grass with no abnormalities seen in eating behaviour.
- She has a Grade 4/5 lameness in left front leg. There is swelling and inflammation in the area of her left front flexor tendons. The horse reacts in response to pain when these flexor tendons are palpated.
- Hooves have recently been trimmed and front hoof cracks treated by farrier.
- Multiple small wounds on medial aspect of right back leg (minor)
- Few ticks are seen under the tail and a few bot worm eggs are present on the coat.

Comments

This horse has a history of neglect and although she is still in poor condition, I believe she has gained weight recently. She is eating well and will do well with the correct care such as correct feeding, regular deworming, hoof care and dental attention. She has injured her left front leg flexor tendons, but with appropriate treatment and rest is expected to make a full recovery.

Examination Findings on 9 April 2025

- Horse is in poor body condition. Body condition score of 2.5/9 (Good being 4.5/9).
- Mentation is alert and attentive, she has a healthy appetite.
- Molars in maxilla have slight hooks left and right, but she is able to chew grass with no abnormalities seen in eating behaviour.
- She has a Grade 4/5 lameness in left front leg. There is swelling and inflammation in the area of her left front flexor tendons. The horse reacts in response to pain when these flexor tendons are palpated.
- Hooves have recently been trimmed and front hoof cracks treated by farrier.
- Multiple small wounds on medial aspect of right back leg (minor)
- Few ticks are seen under the tail and a few bot worm eggs are present on the coat.

Follow up examination on 15 April 2025

- Horses are much more interactive. Can already see a slight improvement in condition.
- Lameness in the left front leg improved to Grade 2/5.
- Swelling around flexor tendons have subsided and she is not reacting to digital palpation anymore.
- Wound noted at coronary band on left front leg. Foul smelling exudate from the wound suggests a hoof abscess that has erupted at the coronary band.

Comments

This horse has a history of neglect and although she is still in poor condition, I believe she has gained weight recently. She is eating well and will do well with the correct care such as correct feeding, regular deworming, hoof care and dental attention.

She has injured her left front leg flexor tendons, but with appropriate treatment and rest is expected to make a full recovery.

The hoof abscess is draining at the moment but a farrier will be required to investigate and open the abscess in the hoof itself as soon as possible.

Health Report:

Equine, Thoroughbred, Mare, Bay, 13yrs Est

On 17/03/25 a horse was presented for general health check and report by the owner Mr D Coetzee.

History: The horse was rescued and re-homed to the current owner about seven months before. Photos from the time of acquisition show a severely emaciated horse of a body condition score of about 1 (BCS scale; 1 being emaciated and 5 severely obese). The owners do not have much previous experience with horses.

Care given during this time included one deworming in January and one farrier visit for a hoof trim.

Clinical findings: Clinical parameters were within normal limits. Multiple small lesions were present in the medial aspect of the right hind leg which the owners disinfected and treated. The horse had a good appetite for the lucerne that was in the feeding trough. She had an alert, positive and inquisitive demeanor and interacted well with the owners. The BCS was about a 2 (still to lean). Hooves were not shod, the right front was splintering and was in need of trimming again. Good chewing motion was observed and food was not dropped as with severe dental malocclusions. No ticks or other external parasites other than Bot fly eggs on the medial front legs were observed. No further clinical tests were done or samples taken.

Environment: The horse was held in a safe and non-threatening enclosure with free access to lucerne and water. No sharp objects were seen and the property was securely closed.

Recommendations: Owner was informed about the fast metabolism of thoroughbreds and that they generally do not do well on pasture and lucerne alone. He was advised to add at least 2 kg maintenance concentrates twice per day to the ration. The teeth can be floated for better chewing and digestion of the feed given. Regular deworming every 3 months was advised. The frequency of at least two moths between farrier visits was advised to keep the horse sound. We would gladly do a follow-up to help and reassess the progress in two months time.

Horse attended to at the SPCA in Mosselbay. Bay mare had the following issues.

Big abscess on the front hoof at the hairline which also had a torn tendon, other hoof had flat heels and flat soles and broken back angles.

Back hooves flat heels and flares with broken back angles.

After trimming.

Opened abscess and took pressure off the pressure point. Managed to win a few degrees on the toe and heel to get the pastern and hoof angle in a better equilibrium.

Back hooves took the flares as much as allowed and corrected the angles on the back.

Recommend a 5 week trimming cycle for the mare as her hooves still need to be worked on as they are only in the beginning stages of getting her all sound and happy again with a more natural hoof angle and depth of sole.

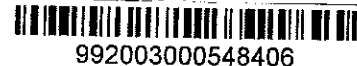

 3. All animals treated by the SPCA must be sterilised. I hereby consent to the sterilisation of the above animal. If I refuse, I accept treatment could be denied.
 4. If in the opinion of a veterinarian an animal presented for admission is so diseased, severely injured or in such a physical condition that it should be euthanised for humane reasons, the Society shall have the right to effect such euthanasia by approved humane methods.
 5. I will collect the animal, or make arrangements with the Society to get the animal home within 48 hours of being told by the Society that the animal can go home. If I do not collect the animal within the time stated by the Society, the animal will become the property of the Society and I will have no claim whatsoever against the Society.
 6. Should the decision on specific treatment be required due to the cost thereof, only 24 hours will be permitted. Therefore a decision will be made in the best interest of the animal, and in terms of Section 5 of Animal Protection Act 71 of 1962. Please note that the euthanasia is considered a form of treatment.

- I indemnify the Society, its employees, Veterinarian for any loss, damage, disease, injury or death of the above animal, from what-so-ever cause.
