General Report Comments: OBTAINED A WARRANT FROM THE BOOYSENS MAGISTRATE COURT. ACCOMPANIED BY SENIOR INSPECTOR ISRAEK LUKHELI AND INSPECTOR KYLE APPALSAMY WITH TWO POLICE OFFICERS FROM THE BOOYSENS SAPS WERE MANAGED TO GET ON THE PROPERTY. AN ADULT BLACK AN TAN AFRICANIS CROSS MALE DOG WAS OBSERVED ROAMING FREELY IN THE FRONTYARD, TWO ADULT PITBULL TYPE DOGS, A BLACK AND WHITE FEMALE AND A GREY AND WHITE MALE WERE FOUND CONFINED IN THE BACKYARD OF THE PREMISES, SUFFICIENT SPAVE AVAILABLE. ALL THREE DOGS WERE FOUND IN AN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION AND THE FEMALE DOG APPEARED PREGNANT. THE TWO PITBULLS WERE FOUND WITH INSUFFICIENT SHELTER, HAZARDOUS MATERIALS AND RUBBLE LITTERED THE BACKYARD. A WARNING WAS ISSUED FOR INSUFFICIENT WATER PROVISION, INADEQAUTE SHELTER AND THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS. NO SIGN OF THE DOGS BEING INVOLVED IN DOG FIGHTING FROM CLOSE EXAMINATION. THE OWNER WAS ALSO REQUESTED TO SEPARATE THE FEMALE DOG FROM THE MALE DOG AS SHE WAS HEAVILY PREGNANT. FOLLOW UP IN 24HRS.
