Report/Findings: Upon arrival all 3 dogs appeared to be in poor condition the adult male had a wound on the shoulder the puppy & mother dog appeared to be underweight. The living conditions were deemed not suitable, dirty area, small kennels, no food & water made available. dogs kept in a small space, the property did not afford adequate space to house any animals, the dogs were surrendered to the SPCA as Maria Mahlango stated that the kids are the ones that brought the dogs to the yard without her consent.
