Both dogs could walk, the owner stated that it is an allergic reaction & has previously occurred & left on its own. The owner was advised to take the dog to a vet. Drinking water was observed to be very Dirty the owner was advised to ensure that the dogs have potable drinking water at all times. A warning was issued for the concerns raised & the owner was further advised to sterilise his dogs and to also provide forms of enrichment to help reduce potential conflict amongst both males.
