Report/Findings: Upon arrival it was noted that 2 dogs had bite wounds which were sustained from fighting. 1 female was on heat which may have led to the dogs attacking each other as the owners stated they never fight. The owner was further advised to sign over some of the dogs & a warning was issued for veterinary attention for the 2 dogs. The 3 dogs remained in fair condition with no visible scarring/wounds. The owner was advised to have his dogs sterilised to avoid future instances. Surrendering was declined.

Report/Findings: Upon telephone follow-up the owner informed us that the 2 dogs were taken to Vorna Valley Animal Clinic for examination where the 1 dog was put down & the other received medical attention, the owner was again advised on sterilisation of all remaining dogs. A vet's report was requested regarding the 2 dogs taken to the vet where the owner stated they would have to request it in writing from the clinic.
