Dear: To Whom It May Concern

I am writing to formally express my deep concern regarding the extremely poor conditions in which some animals—particularly two ostriches—are being kept at bokkie park. As a resident living nearby, I witness these conditions on a daily basis, and I feel compelled to speak out on behalf of these voiceless creatures.

The ostriches appear to be in very poor health and are living in unsuitable, unhygienic environments. They have no proper shelter to protect them from harsh weather conditions, including the cold mornings I witness frequently. Their water supply is visibly dirty, and they do not seem to have access to clean, sufficient food. Their feathers are matted with dirt, and the animals appear severely neglected.

As an establishment that presents itself as a nature or animal park, there is an ethical and moral responsibility to ensure all animals are treated humanely, with appropriate care, shelter, and nourishment. What I see daily is far from acceptable and falls below any reasonable standard of animal welfare.

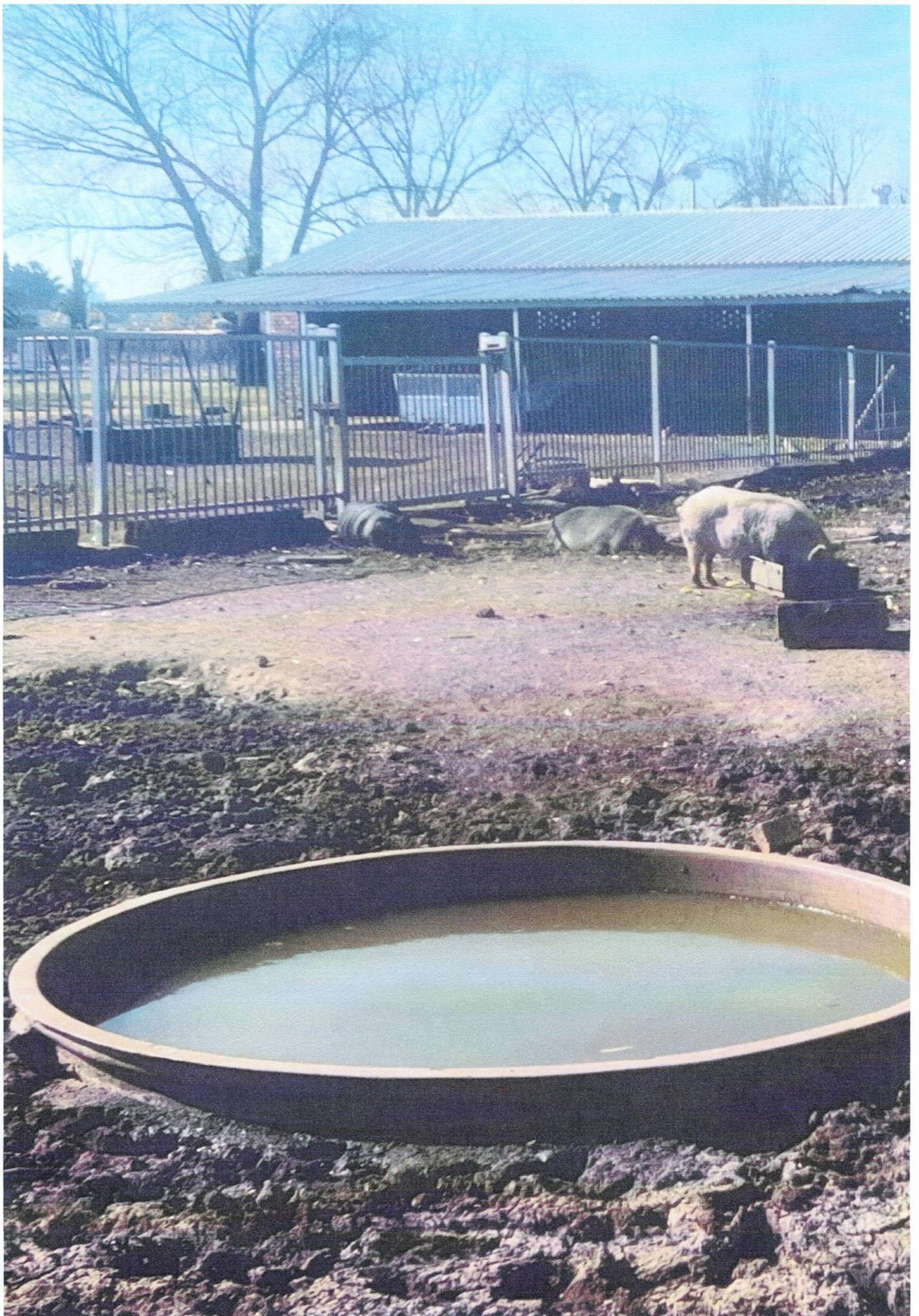
