Your complaint has been sent through to the Boksburg SPCA as it falls in their area of jurisdiction.

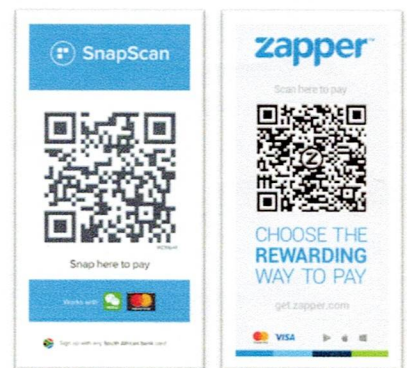

I was at the Loolilocks Koi Farm today, and I noticed multiple lemur and monkey cages, however the main concern of what I saw lies with the two fennec foxes they are keeping at the back of the property.

These foxes are being held separately, in extremely small cages, and they seem visibly distressed. One has a spot of hair missing, which I assume it has pulled out due to its environmental factors.

Please look into this if possible as it was distressing seeing these exotic animals being confined to such tiny cages.
