Background

The Boksburg SPCA inspectorate received a complaint about the handling and treatment of the sheep at the Bokkie Park following a post in a whatsapp group about a sick sheep. Videos showing the Bokkie Park staff and their handling of the sheep were included.

Inspection

I met with Jaco Berger on 1st November 2025 at 08h00. He took me to the area where the sheep and goat are housed after hours and showed me the sick sheep that was in quarantine, **(Photo 1)**. He explained that the sheep showed signs of a worm infestation. He decided to deworm all the sheep as a precautionary measure and shared the footage on the whatsapp group.

Findings

- 1 x Sick sheep, quarantined. Sheep was dewormed and isolated while been monitored.
- 7 x Sheep grazing around the park. All appeared healthy and no other sick animals were seen at this time.

Animals in Question

- 8 Sheep

Follow-up

A follow-up inspection was conducted on **5th November 2025 at 08h30.**

- The sick sheep was still isolated and appeared much better and was eating and drinking normally. **(Photo 3)** *(Follow up on 7th November)*

- A warning addressing the dragging of sheep by the legs and horns as shown in the footage and alternative herding process was issued.
- The complainant was contacted on 5th and 7th November 2025 and updated on the progress and status of the investigation pending the final follow up.

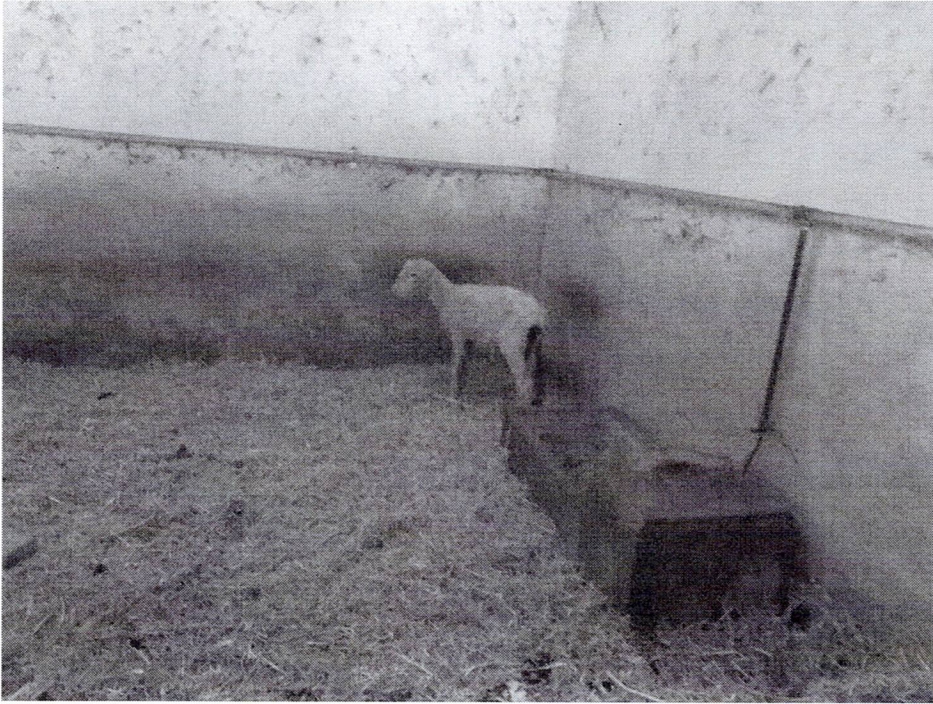
