Please find below the veterinary report for surrender no. 40471, from 16 Miami Close, Portland on 24 August 2021

ANIMAL DETAILS

Species: Canine

EXAMINATION FINDINGS

On physical examination, the dog was of fair body condition, with a body condition score of 2-2.5/5 (normal being 2.5-3/5). The dog also had a moderate weight bearing lameness on the right front limb.

There was also evidence of bite wounds on this leg, and radiographs showed a radiolucent area of the mid ulnar diaphysis, as well as a radiopaque fragment in the same area. This is consistent with a sequestrum, after a fracture to the bone in this area.

Physical examination was otherwise normal.

COMMENTS

I believe the injuries are likely due to bite wounds to the right front leg, obviously severe enough to lead to the sequestrum formation following a fracture. I do not believe adequate veterinary care was obtained soon enough, although the animal was admittedly surrendered and I cannot definitively rule out any form of prior veterinary involvement.
