The facts contained in this affidavit fall within my personal knowledge unless indicated otherwise or unless it appears so from the context. The facts are also, to the best of my knowledge and belief, both true and correct.

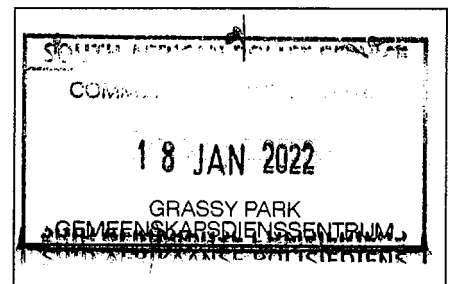
On the 6th of January 2022, at approximately 13H30, I received a call from our Control room informing me to collect an aggressive dog from number 36 Giraffe Street in Eastridge, Mitchells Plain as the owner did not want the dog anymore.

3.1.

Upon my arrival, I was greeted by an individual identified as Ayabonga Mashexa ("the owner"). He took me to where the dog was. I observed a Pitbull-x type dog (Tan/white, Intact-male, Adult). The dog was on a short chain and there were a lot of flies around the dog. The dog had wire wrapped around his hind legs. The dog could not stand-up or walk. The dog appeared to be in pain as when I wanted to lift the dog the dog tried to bite me. I had to carefully pick up the dog to load the dog into my vehicle as I did not want the dog to endure any further pain. I asked the owner why did he tie the legs of the dog and he disclosed that the dog bit him a while ago and that he took wire and placed it around the dog's legs as he was now afraid of the dog. After I loaded the dog into my vehicle I left the property and drove to the SPCA.

When I arrived at the SPCA Hospital off-loading bay, Inspector Carina Bodenstein met with me to examine the dog (*refer to Carina Bodenstein's statement*), there after the dog was taken to Dr. Ramnana for assessment (*refer "Veterinary Report"*).

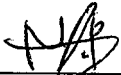
I am of the opinion that the owner intentionally harmed the dog and the actions of the owner was cruel and caused the dog to suffer unnecessarily.

I know and understand the content of this declaration.

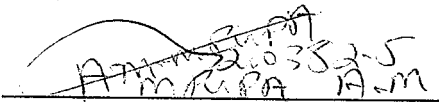
I have no objection to taking the prescribed oath.
