EXAMINATION FINDINGS

Upon examination, the dog was in good body condition. The dog was aggressive when handled. On examination a wire was wrapped around both hind legs, just above the hock. The wire had cut into the layers of skin into layers of muscle.

Clinical exam of the dog:
Temperature: 40°C
Pulse: 160 beats per minute
Respiration: Panting
Mucus membranes: Pink
Blood smear: Neutrophils, toxic neutrophils present

COMMENTS

This dog was in an extreme amount of pain when brought to the SPCA. The dog had to be sedated in order to be handled.

The wire was wrapped around the leg nine times. Presence of maggots were noted when the wire was removed.

Based on clinical exam, this dog suffered for hours – days. The dog could not stand and due to the severity of the dog's condition, the dog was humanely euthanized to prevent further unnecessary suffering.
