History: The horse was bitten by a dog on the right on his sheath about a week ago. The owner has been treating the wound.

Clinical evaluation: I examined the horse on Monday, 24 January 2022. Wound on right lateral sheath, V-shaped and about 3cm long. Skin crusted and scabbed. No discharge from the wound.

Treatment: Old wound, to heal by second intention. Wash the wound with hibiscrub twice a day and apply wound ointment. Oral antibiotics and anti-inflammatories for 5 days. Vaccinated the horse for tetanus. Follow up in necessary.

Prognosis: Good
