hyporexia one weeks duration

HISTORY

Owner says Furia has been hyporexic for the last week and is overall quite lethargic.
Food normally consists of bone meal and vegetables, no pellets. She lives in a pack setting and they sometimes grab things from each other.
Frequent vomiting, unknown about diarrhoea. They think she has lost weight but unsure over how long of a period

CLINICAL

BCS 1/5 - very poor
Habitus 2+, T(37.9)P (60) R (20) - WNL,
MM - pink moist, CRT - 2sec, hydration - WNL
Thoracic auscultation - NAD,
Abdominal palpation - very firm, nodular structure palpated in cranioventral abdomen, does to be attached to either spleen or liver.
EENT - WNL, Inn - NAD,
musculoskeletal - poor muscle condition
skin & coat - dull

ABD RADS

no specific mass visualized but the seems to be a slight mass effect with lumen of the intestines seemingly occluded in one area. Overall cranio-ventral abd appears 'whiter' than normal

Abd US

Structure located in cranioventral abdomen - appearance of a bovine type kidney? Liver kidneys and spleen appear normal. Possible limb of pancreas? Lymph nodes?

DISCUSSION WITH OWNER

Highly suspicious of cancer. Cant confirm without further diagnostics.
Would recommend abd US with WIL as next step.

If owner does not pursue further diagnostics and treatment I would recommend PTS esp considering

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she is not keeping food down, is losing weight, lethargic and overall declining quite rapidly. She will continue to decline with QOL significantly decreasing. Owner seems as though she will PTS. She just needs a bit of time to process the information TX - cerenia - mirtazepine - GI liquid diet Only dispensed meds for two days - cost sensitive case, owner can always come collect more if needed but would ultimately recommend PTS.
