Dear Bruce

Unfortunately, CARE does not have the required permit to accept an import into Gauteng. Their permit only allows them to accept imports into Limpopo and not other provinces. Seeing as the baboon will be flying into OR Tambo International Airport, this is outside of the permit jurisdiction of CARE. JWVH has the required permit to accept the import of the baboon into Gauteng and facilitate the export to Limpopo to CARE.

JWVH will also provide the baboon with intermediate care, and it is only responsible for a veterinarian to assess the baboon after the flight to ensure the animal is sound and that no issues arose during the flight. JWVH has kindly agreed to take on this responsibility at their cost.

We trust this clarifies and meets your approval.

Subject: Rule 6.18 - Awaiting permit to transfer baboon to JWVH

Good day Colleagues

We trust that this email finds you well.

On Saturday, 16 September 2023 we admitted a baboon and her infant. The baboon was attacked by dogs and had to be humanely euthanised due to the extent of her injuries. This left the infant orphaned. The infant is approximately 6 months of age. Admission number A0250.

We have applied for a permit from Cape Nature on Saturday, 16 September 2023 for the infant to be transferred to the Johannesburg Wildlife Veterinary Hospital, whereafter the infant will be transferred to CARE for long-term rehabilitation and release. Further documentation was requested by Cape Nature, which we have submitted. We now await feedback on the permit. We hope to hear today; otherwise, it will only be tomorrow. The 5-day holding period however ends today.

We please ask for an exemption in terms of rule 6.18 to keep the infant until the close of business tomorrow to hear the outcome of the permit application. Should the permit be granted, we will fly the baboon to Johannesburg ASAP and the JWVH will collect the infant at the airport.

Attached is the veterinary report on the infant, who has been declared fit for travel by an independent veterinarian.

Looking forward to your response.
