Comments by Inspector:

The minor handling errors observed had been addressed with the staff member on site. This had been rectified immediately.

The staff used the prodders in accordance with the SANS codes.

All transportation concerns had been addressed and no one was allowed to load any animal if their vehicle was not compliant with the APA and relevant SANS codes.

Injured animals, two sheep presenting slight lameness, had been sold but only for immediate slaughter. The sheep was not fully lame and did put some pressure on their legs.
