EXAMINATION FINDINGS

On clinical examination of the dog, it has been found that the animal is in a fair to bad condition, and there is also signs of the animal being under fed, with an unhealthy dry and scabby hair coat. There is also evidence of ticks and fleas all over his body, including in and around the ears.

On blood smear it was evident that the animal has Canine Ehrlichia, (tick-bite fever) And will therefore be treated for this condition at our facility, as the diagnosis could be made from the blood smear, and presence of ticks on his body.

- **Recommendation:** The animal needs medical attention, to clear up the tick and flea infestation and to also treat the Ehrlichia that the animal currently suffers from. If no medical attention is applied, or any treatment given, the animal will definitely die from this.

COMMENTS

Its evident the animal has been suffering from animal neglected over some time, due to the current health condition the dog is in, and that he definitely needs medical attention. This animal should have been taken to a Veterinary practitioner sooner, to attend to his degrading health condition and this was also neglected. His general health and skin condition show that there was very limited to no care for this animal, wherever it was removed from.
