In light of the inspection that was conducted at your facility on 19 December 2023, **you are hereby warned that:**

1. The enclosures were observed to be broken and in poor condition, which could lead to unnecessary injury and harm to the dogs. The enclosures need to be repaired and well-maintained at all times. You have **7 days** to rectify this.
2. There is one enclosure that does not have correct flooring but only sand. This could potentially cause parasitic conditions for the dog which will lead to unnecessary suffering. It is also advised that you place a rubber mat inside both enclosures. The enclosure needs to have solid, non-slip flooring. You have **7 days** to rectify this.
3. The enclosures had a build-up of dog hair on the sides as well as urine stains. You need to hygienically clean and maintain the enclosures. You have **7 days** to rectify this.
4. One of the enclosures is too small and not of regulation size for the dog. You need to ensure that this is addressed within **7 days** and ensure that the dog has access to adequate space when inside the enclosure.
5. Full details of the working dogs are required as well as Dog Handling (DH) certificates are required of all the handlers. You have **7 days** to rectify this.
6. Your employees could not present a valid license in terms of the Performing Animals Protection Act (PAPA) upon the inspectors' request. This is in direct contravention of the aforesaid Act and needs to be rectified immediately (see special conditions listed in the PAPA). You are also requested to send your updated and valid PAPA License within **24 hours**.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act No 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 and / or Performing Animals Protection Act No 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
