I reported animal abuse to you yesterday. I wanted to inform you that I walked past the subway in Lansdowne this afternoon. I saw 3 dogs there. The one dog looked very thin, he was limping, his front right paw. He is light brown in colour, with white paws. These bergies were fighting, the poor dog was between them. Please can you help as soon as possible. I even saw a tiny black puppy under a Bakkie, I am not sure if this puppy belonged to anyone. As there was a guy bending down looking at the dog. But if you check along the subway leading under the bridge you will see these people. It hurts me to see these dogs. I am in a flat, otherwise I will save them all. And please check the corner of Rouxton Crescent and Lansdowne road, Lansdowne. As I said there are a few dogs there. Nobody in sight. There is a metal gate, looks like a small face brick place, like an old public toilet. Opposite white flats. Please I plead if you to help these poor animals. When I saw the dog limping and landing up between bergies fighting, broke my heart.

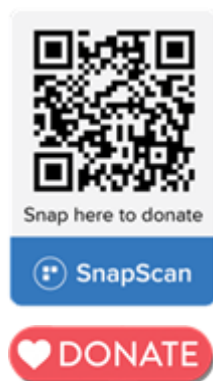

I would like to report the following animal abuse:

Its in Lansdowne

The corner or Rouxton Crescent and Lansdowne road

Lansdowne

You will see silver metal fencing and a face brick place inside. Looks like it could have been public toilets. I have walked over the walkway bridge their, and I saw about 4 dogs there unattended to or maybe belonging to some drunk bergies. The one dog looked like a black Labrador x, the other possibly a Maltese, he or she was brown and black, I can't remember the other two. I think the other one was white. All I know it is cruel. They are barking and very unhappy. I know there are rats around there as well. Please could you rescue and save these dogs please.,It's close to the police station in Lansdowne, opposite a ugly whitish block of flats with the name scratched off. Please help them, save them.

Also in Hamlet Road, Lansdowne, opposite Windsor Hamlet Court, a whole lot of bergies were there,, the police removed them on Saturday. But they are now hanging around the pavements and under the bridge by the subway. There are two dogs. Both black and brown in colour. The one doggie looks like a Beagle x Please save them, these bergies have no money, they can't look after these dogs. These dogs have no food, no water. There are rats I running around like cats there.

Please save these dogs., there is also a cat there called Biscuit rhat they have. Please help and save these animals please. They deserve a good caring home. Please rescue them. 🙏🙏🙏🙏
