You are hereby warned that:

1. During an inspection at Swissport two crates from a shipment with Airwaybill 125 5367 1564, were observed to not have any water. It is a requirement in terms of the Animals Protection Act no 71 of 1962 and IATA Live Animals Regulations to ensure that potable water is always provided to animals. The necessary protocols must be implemented to ensure that water is provided to the animals as soon as they are received in the cargo warehouse.
2. It was observed during the inspection that there was not sufficient ventilation in the AVI room. The door of the room must be left open or sufficient artificial ventilation must be provided to ensure that animals are not exposed to excessive heat.
3. A designated person(s) must be identified by Swissport to act as an AVI officer(s) to ensure the needs of the animals when they are received in the cargo warehouse in terms of IATA Live Animals Regulations.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act No 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 and / or Performing Animals Protection Act No 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
