EXAMINATION FINDINGS

- A. Clinical parameters were within normal limits; however, this animal was not able to walk and was dragging its hindlegs. The body condition score according to the Nestlé PURINA Body condition system was 2. The cat had a flea bite allergy and the presence of fleas were excessive throughout the body. The habitus of the cat was depressed.
- B. Clinical parameters were within normal limits. The cat was ataxic on the hindlegs. The body condition score according to the Nestlé PURINA Body condition system was 2. The cat had a severe flea bite allergy and the presence of fleas were excessive throughout the body.
- C. Clinical parameters were within normal limits. The body condition score according to the Nestlé PURINA Body condition system was 3. The cat had a severe flea bite allergy and the presence of fleas were excessive throughout the body. The dewclaw of the front limbs had grown into the skin.
- D. Clinical parameters were within normal limits. The cat was blind, bilateral cataract noted and buphthalmos present. The body condition score according to the Nestlé PURINA Body condition system was 3. The cat had flea bite allergy and the presence of fleas were excessive throughout the body.
- E. Clinical parameters were within normal limits. The body condition score according to the Nestlé PURINA Body condition system was 4. There was presence of excessive fleas.
- F. Clinical parameters were within normal limits. The body condition score according to the Nestlé PURINA Body condition system was 4. There was presence of excessive fleas.
- G. Clinical parameters were within normal limits. The body condition score according to the Nestlé PURINA Body condition system was 4. There was presence of excessive fleas.

- H. Clinical parameters were within normal limits. The body condition score according to the Nestlé PURINA Body condition system was 4. There was presence of excessive fleas.

COMMENTS

- A. The animal had cervical and thoracolumbar spondylosis as well as some degree of hip dysplasia and could not walk.
