In light of the inspection conducted at your facility on 08 March 2023, **you are hereby warned that:**

1. The current location of the Live Animal Holding area is not suitable or conducive for the welfare and wellbeing of the animals being housed there. The animals in the holding area are exposed to constant loud noises and noxious fumes from forklifts. There is also an electric connection where water is dripping onto it, which poses severe risks to both the animals and humans.
 - A. A suitable area within your warehouse needs to be identified or the current area must be altered to avoid the animals being exposed to constant loud noises and noxious fumes from forklifts. It is suggested that a separate room is used as the Live Animal Holding area or the wooden Wendy house which is currently used must be moved and alternations made to improve ventilation. This must be rectified within **14 days** from the issue of this warning.

We wish to draw your attention to Section 2(1)(a), (b) and (m(ii)) of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 and chapter 10.2 of the IATA Live Animal Regulations.

2. Bird crates were found stacked on top of each other. Bird crates should not be stacked on top of one another as this could result in the crates falling over and the birds may be injured in the process and/or escape.

We wish to draw your attention to Section 2(1)(r) of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act No 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 and / or Performing Animals Protection Act No 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
