You are hereby warned that:

In light of a recent inspection conducted on 09 March 2023, the following was observed and needs to **be rectified within the following 7 days, unless indicated otherwise in the text.**

1. Rotten meat was observed in the deep freeze in the kitchen, and I was informed that this meat is fed to the dogs;
 - a. The dogs must be fed adequately on a daily basis with food that is of good quality and sufficient quantity (based on age, and activity). If you persist in providing your dogs with raw meat, ensure the meat is fresh and kept in an area that will maintain the freshness;
 - b. The deep freeze was also dirty/unhygienic and needs to be cleaned thoroughly.
2. Two German Shepherds, named "Alex" and "Mac," appeared to have slanted hips;
 - a. Ensure to provide them with veterinary treatment, as discussed, within 72 hours and provide us with a veterinary report and X-Rays;
 - b. These dogs are not to be worked unless an up-to-date veterinary report can be provided, stating they are fit for duty.
3. The Jack Russel named "Joker" appears to walk with difficulty, is deaf, and not working;
 - a. Provide "Joker" with veterinary treatment within 72 hours and provide us with the veterinary report.
4. The dogs that are not working are to be removed from the cages in which they are kept;
 - a. Confining the dogs in these cages are considered unnecessary;
 - b. Ensure to provide an alternative living condition for the dogs, either by rehoming them into an environment where they will be able to free roam; or
 - c. Alternatively, surrender the dogs to the Cape of Good Hope SPCA.
5. The drainage system between blocks C and D does not work correctly. The urine and excrement pool up and cause parasitic conditions;
 - a. Refrain from using these kennels with immediate effect, until this matter has been resolved.
6. The training obstacle course has obstacles that are broken and delapidated;
 - a. Ensure to fix/remove the broken obstacles from the course as they can cause unnecessary injury/harm to the animal/s.
7. The kennel enclosure of "Azaro," a Belgian Malinois, had bedding/ old material on top of the roof, which was pulled through by "Azaro";
 - a. Remove this material as this can cause veterinary concerns if eaten and parasitic conditions.
8. Lots of rubble were kept at the back by the isolation kennel enclosures;
 - a. Ensure to remove this as this is a fire hazard.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act No 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 and / or Performing Animals Protection Act No 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
