FARRIER REPORT FALLEN ANGELS

This communication serves to confirm that, St.John Midgley (RF) of St.Romnik Farrier Services, is over-seeing the hoof care of the Fallen Angels – equines, ovines, camelides and porcines.

Specifically it is confirmed that the horses, donkeys, Jinx and the sheep with the prosthesis have farrier care on a 6 weekly basis. The remaining, sheep, goats, alpacas and pigs are attended to on a 12 week basis. The next consultation is booked for, Friday 10 March 2023.

St.Romnik Farrier Services have been the primary farrier of Fallen Angels since 2017 and have worked closely with the organisation to ensure that the ungulate animals receive correct and regular farrier care.

We are advised that there is concern regarding the condition of the donkey's hooves. It is important to note that these donkeys arrived at the organisation and were clearly unused to handling. It was also evident that the donkeys had not received farrier care in excess of 6 months. In addition to this, there was obvious laminitic pathology of the hooves, in particular rotation of the distal phalanx, because of this the hoof growth pattern is abnormal and will always present as such. We have advised Fallen Angels in the management of the donkeys to avoid further laminitic episodes – a high fibre, low sugar diet, limited access to green grass, structured slow exercise and regular farrier work.
