Please find below the veterinary report for Admission Number 90114, confiscated from Belville South on the 10th March 2023.

ANIMAL DETAILS

Species : Canine
Breed: Pitbull type
Sex: Male, intact
Age: Adult
Name: Unknown
Description: White with black spots

EXAMINATION FINDINGS

- **Description** – The dog presented bright, alert, responsive and friendly. He was slightly under weight with a Body Condition Score of 4/9. He had fleas and evidence of fleas dirt and mild alopecia along the dorsum. The dog is pruritic -this is expected to be due to flea allergic dermatitis. The dog is in otherwise fair health.
- **Duration** – a few months approximately.
- **Cause** – neglect by owner. No tick and flea treatments were given.
- **Prognosis** – Based on clinical examination – the dog is expected to be able to live a normal and healthy life if proper treatment (sufficient nutrients and tick and flea prevention) is given.
- **Recommendation** – Owner is in breach of basic animal rights (Animal Protection Act 71 of 1962). He should be charged accordingly.

COMMENTS

This dog needs tick and flea treatment as well as some cortisone to decrease the allergic dermatitis.
