To whom it may concern

On 20 April 2023 at approximately 14h40 SPCA Inspector Lee presented a dog collected from 76 Bramble Way. The owners allege that the dog was stabbed by someone.

EXAMINATION FINDINGS

- **Description** - The dog was in hypovolemic shock resulting from hemorrhage (bleeding out) as a direct result of the stab wound, there was a large amount of blood present and the dog's condition was very poor on presentation. The dog looked well looked after and aside from abnormalities due to a stab wound there weren't any others of concern to be noted.
- **Cause** - stab wound to right side of dog in area of last rib and abdomen (around 1 inch stab incision seen)
- **Prognosis** – very poor due to severity upon presentation
- **Recommendation** - animal was euthanized on arrival due to a stab wound that was causing him to hemorrhage internally (bleed out).

COMMENTS

The dog was in hypovolemic shock resulting from hemorrhage (bleeding out) as a direct result of the stab wound, most likely due to sharp trauma to internal organs such as the lung or liver that are in the area of the stab wound.
